GRACE LUTHERAN SCHOOL INVESTING \$2.7 MILLION IN IMPROVEMENTS

Grace Lutheran School in Fargo is investing \$2.7 million in capital improvements. Construction bids are awarded to Meineke Johnson, SA Mechanical, and Dakota Electric. Construction will commence in June 2024 with a groundbreaking ceremony on Tuesday, May 21 at 1:00 pm. The press is invited to this ceremony.

The GROWING TOGETHER IN GRACE campaign is a multi-phase project that provides building and security upgrades, a state-of-the-art geothermal heating and cooling system, classroom updates, and ultimately adds more classroom, administrative, and student space to accommodate growth. Since 2018, Grace has seen enrollment increase by 50%.

Grace Lutheran School has provided the Fargo-Moorhead-West Fargo community with Christ-centered education since 1948 serving students from Pre-Kindergarten through 8th Grade.

Grace Lutheran School is a ministry of the Red River Lutheran School Association and is owned and operated by six local churches: Beautiful Savior - Fargo, Grace - Fargo, Immanuel - Fargo, Our Redeemer - Moorhead, St Andrew - West Fargo, and Trinity - Sabin. Grace Lutheran School is part of The Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod, which operates the largest Protestant school system in the United States.
