#### FREE & REDUCED LUNCH APPLICATIONS

The free and reduced meal program is a wonderful program for both our families and our school. Our school receives funds for supplemental educational tools when our families submit applications and qualify for free or reduced meals. ## PIANO LESSONS WITH REBEKAH UHLHORN


Rebekah Uhlhorn partners with Grace Lutheran School to offer piano lessons before and after school. She has a couple of openings remaining for this school year.

## PARKING, DROP OFF, AND PICK UP AT ST ANDREW & IMMANUEL

## ST ANDREW LUTHERAN CHURCH



St Andrew: For moving drop off and pick up (without leaving vehicle), enter the St Andrew parking lot on the east side from 2nd Street and proceed to drop off/pick up area on the south side of the building. Students dropped off may use the south entrance (Door 3).

St Andrew has ample parking if you wish to walk you child into the building. Please use the designated parking areas and proceed to the east door (Door 1).

At 3:10/3:20 students will be outside for pick up on the south side of the building. Parents may use the moving pickup line to pick up their student(s) without leaving their vehicle OR, parents may park park in

the designated parking area and walk to the south side to retrieve their student(s). Students will not be sent across the parking lot to a parents car.

For student safety, do not attempt to drop off or pick up anywhere near the east side of the building.

Aftercare pick up: park in designated parking areas and use the east entrance (Door 1).

Immanuel: On Monday, September 16, and Monday, September 23, please use the parking lot and door on the west side of Immanuel (accessible via 7th Street or 13th Avenue).

For drop off and pick up, please park your car in the west lot and escort your child to or from the building. There will not be a moving pick up or drop off line at Immanuel. Do not park along the edge of the building.

At 3:10/3:20, students will be outside on the west side of the building. Again, park your car and retrieve your child. Students will not be sent across

the parking lot to a parents car.
