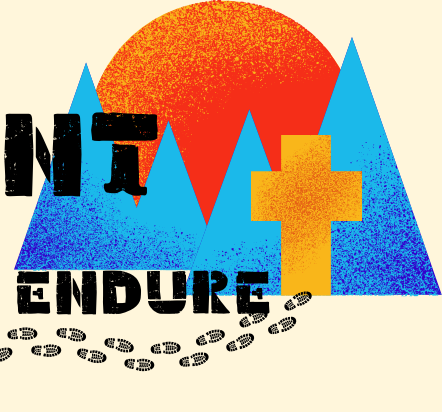

## PERTUSSIS ON THE RISE IN FARGO

With pertussis (whooping cough) cases on the rise in North Dakota, we wanted to pass along some information about pertussis to our families.

Pertussis is a reportable condition, meaning any student who is diagnosed with pertussis is reported to the State and all school families are notified of exposure to a student with pertussis.

Grace students got an early start on respiratory illness this year. Please familiarize yourself with pertussis symptoms in case it hits our building.
