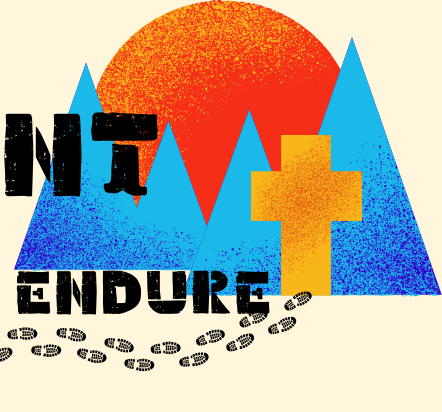




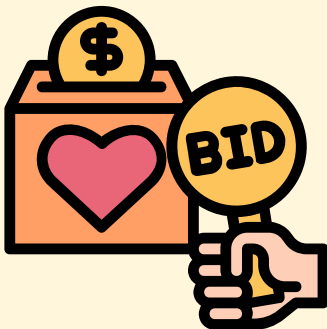

TRAILER NEEDED

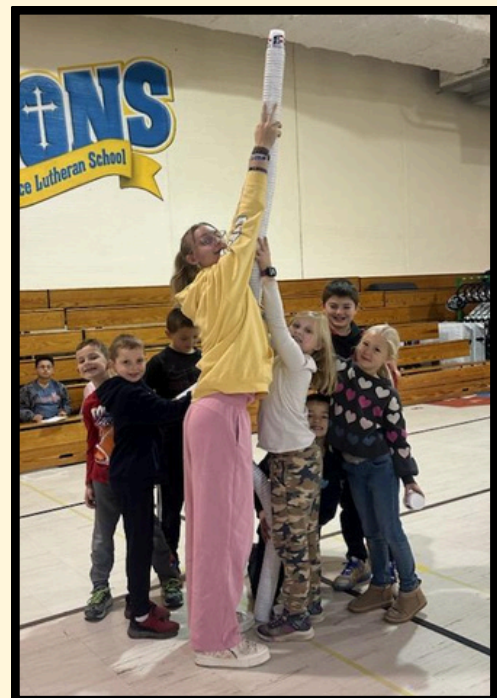

GET READY FOR COLD WEATHER

It's a' comin'! Summer today, winter tomorrow. Now is an excellent time to pull out coats, snowpants, boots, etc, so the first snowfall doesn't leave you scrambling.

Pre-K through 5th grade go out for recess every day. Snow gear is required if there is snow on the ground. Students without boots do not get to play in the snow.

Once the snow gets here, it is advisable to have 2 pairs of mittens for your child if they go to aftercare, as the first pair is usually still wet after school. Extra socks for every student is also helpful.
