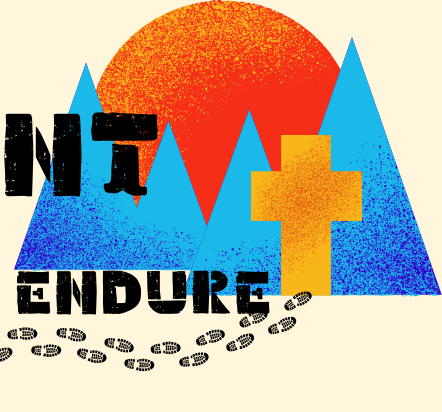

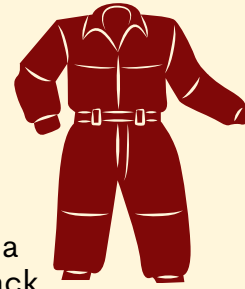
Dear Parents,
