LOST LIBRARY BOOK POLICY CHANGE

Please note the following handbook change regarding lost library books. *Changes noted in italics.*

No fines are charged for overdue materials, but the librarian, in consultation with principal, may establish other procedures for material recovery. The school charges for lost materials or materials beyond repair. Books and other items overdue or not returned by the *final week of **each quarter*** of the school year shall be considered lost. Parents and guardians will be billed a flat fee of \$25.00 for the replacement of a lost or irreparable book. *Lost books that are paid for but later returned in the same condition and within the same school year shall be refunded the \$25.00 fee.*
